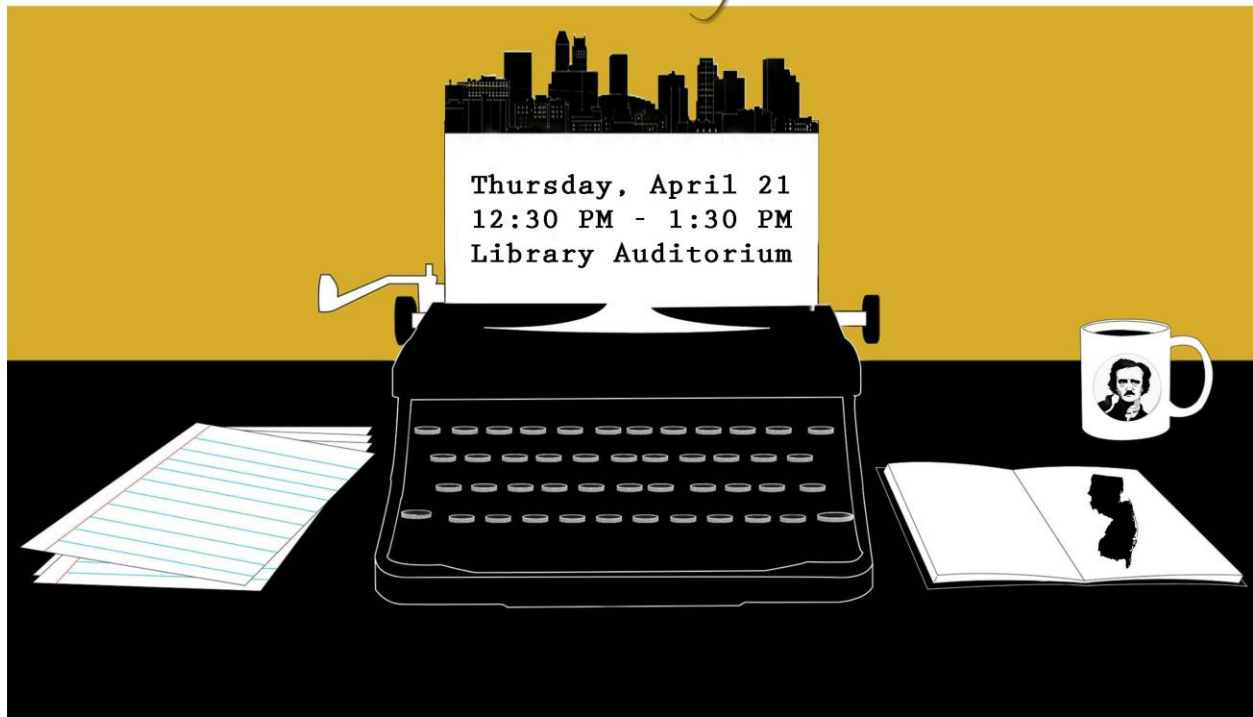


LIVING WRITERS PRESENTS
